1. Did contractor do a thorough inspection of your problem?			
2. Did contractor explain in detail the proposed work he is recommending?			
3. Did contractor provide you with a written estimate in a timely fashion?			
4. Did contractor provide copies of any warranties along with the contract?			
5. Did contractor provide you with a "Notice of Right to Cancel" form, allowing you to cancel the contract within 3 business days?			
6. Did contractor provide you with local references?			
7. Did contractor have proper state registrations and licenses?			
8. Did contractor have proper insurance coverage? (i.e., auto, general liability, worker's compensation)			
9. Is contractor a member of the NAWSRC (National Association of Waterproofing and Structural Repair Contractors) and adhere to the NAWSRC Canon of Ethics and Standards of Practice?			
10. Did Contractor earn your trust and respect as a true professional?
